



## ***WEATHER RELATED CLOSURES/LATE STARTS***

Below you will find the radio and TV stations you should listen to for closures and late starts for the Daycare, K-8, and High School programs. All programs will follow the same status given in the media. **Please do not call the school** to determine the open, late start, or closed status. The large numbers of calls cannot adequately be handled.

In many cases we will follow our local school district's closures, but this is not always the case, so please watch for Community Christian Academy/Northwest Christian High School's information. Our families come from many directions and because of daycare, before and after school care services we will tend to have fewer late starts because of snow and ice. **Please watch and listen closely to the sources listed below for CCA/NCHS specific information.**

Each family should decide their arrival time based on how safe they feel the driving conditions are for them. The distance you come, specific roads you travel, the driver and vehicle you use will determine how safe you feel coming at the regular school start time or later in the morning when the roads are thawed or the snow has melted. **BE SAFE! We will not count students tardy on days that local districts start late due to weather if the student has a parent written excuse.**
