



CCA PASSPORT CLUB!

The Passport Club is a fun and exciting way for the students to learn the geography of the world. Each month the students will be given a passport map to study the current month's countries from level one to five. Each class has been assigned the following levels:

Kindergarten: Level 1

First Grade: Level 1

Second Grade: Level 2

Third Grade: Level 3

Fourth Grade: Level 4

Fifth Grade: Level 5

Sixth Grade: Level 5

Principal Rick Graham has made the Passport Club a curriculum requirement so the Passport testing will count towards the student's grade in Social Studies.

Passport testing is usually from 12:30pm to 3pm on the last Thursday of every month with the following exceptions: the testing in November is on Tuesday, November 22 and the testing in December is on Thursday, December 15. Levels 1 through 4 are countries and Level 5 is the capitol cities of the Level 1 countries. Once the student has attained the required level(s), a passport tester will stamp the section(s) of achieved levels and the student will then proceed to the stamp table to pick out one country stamp for each level attained. This is the fun part!

If your child's teacher sends their map home, we encourage you to assist your child in studying for the Passport club. Helping them the third weekend (adjust this for holiday exceptions) of each month and the evenings prior to the testing day will easily help them to achieve their assigned levels. If you would like to use a blank map to study the countries at home; blank, laminated passport maps are available to purchase at the office for \$1.

We need help! We need parents or grandparents to volunteer to test the students. This is a great activity to count towards your stewardship hours and is an easy activity for parents or grandparents. Grandparents that have helped in the past have loved volunteering and the testing is quite easy. It is also a great way to get to know the students. This is a 2 ½ hour commitment once a month.
